



The Market for Plastic Products in the Kingdom is Rapidly Growing as the Boom in the Construction, Food & Beverage and Retail Sectors Continues...

\$7.5 Billion

Plastic Packaging Market is Rapidly Expanding at 5% Annually...

Packaging products used for food, beverages, cosmetics, household cleaning supplies, as well as premium retail products and medicines are growing, driven by a vibrant economy and greater consumer spending. The plastics market is projected to surpass over \$7.5 billion. This provides widespread opportunities for packaging solutions providers.

Engineering Plastics Market is Spiking...

The Saudi engineering plastics market is projected to be worth \$1.3 billion. The accelerated growth in resin consumption is due to rising usage in the packaging, electrical, electronics and construction industries. Consumption of resins is creating business opportunities for suppliers of resins, machinery, materials and related equipment to meet the needs of the increasing demand.

Saudi Construction Boom Drives Exponential Growth of Emulsion Polymers Market...

The Saudi emulsion polymers market is projected to grow at an annual rate of 6.5%. Increased demand for manufacturing construction materials such as adhesives, paints, coatings, as well as drug delivery systems, gloves, floor polish, films and cosmetics is being driven by the Kingdoms high-growth economy. Robust opportunities for suppliers of the emulsion polymers are expanding in line with demand.

Polyethylene (PE) Pipes Market Rise Fueled by Construction and Infrastructure Activities...

The Saudi PE pipes market will achieve a volume of around 203,247.12 tonnes in 2024. Continued high growth will see the volume grow to 214,832.20 tonnes by 2025. Driven by growing construction and infrastructural activities, providers of downstream raw materials in the petroleum industry are witnessing increased demand for their products as PE usage increases as projected.

Detergents' Market Growth...

The main petrochemical derivate ingredients in soaps and detergents are seeing growth. With the expansion of property developments and increased household needs in line with the expansion of the urban population, is leading to an expansion of the market. With the expansion of existing manufacturing facilities and imports of petrochemical derivatives into the Kingdom, opportunities exist for petrochemicals companies and downstream vendors to provide the market with the required raw materials.

Antimicrobial coatings on plastic packaging to protect healthcare, food and other consumer products has increased at a massive rate. The Saudi market has grown year-on-year at a rate of 7.4% due to heightened health and food safety concerns. With antimicrobial packaging increasing in importance, multiple opportunities for manufacturers and importers of such coatings.

Saudi Tyre Imports by 2026...

Saudi Arabia tyre import market was valued at \$563.3 million in 2024 and is projected to reach \$590.3 million by 2025, and \$618.5 by 2026 at a CAGR of 4.79%. All demand for tyres is met by imports with more than 50 brands imported annually into the Kingdom. The rapid development in the automobile sector of Saudi Arabia is driving the growth of the tyre market.

Big Growth in the Saudi Synthetic Rubber Market...

Synthetic rubber is set to grow exponentially reaching \$250 million. High demand by the automotive industry, as well as the medical and construction sectors, are also contributing to the rapid growth.


The Venue
